In the final poll of the 2010 season, Flanagan High (Pembroke Pines, FL) takes over the top spot to be crowned national champions. Previous No. 1 Klein High of Spring, TX, fell in the 5-A state championship to Corpus Christi's Carroll High. Flanagan's title marks the seventh time a Florida team has finished atop the rankings. It is also the second straight year that the final poll came down to a state championship game in Texas. In 2009, Bishop Gorman High (Las Vegas, NV) benefited from Moody High (Corpus Christi, TX) losing to Texarkana's Texas High in the 4-A finals.

Klein dropped to No. 22 after the loss. Defending national champ Bishop Gorman High (Las Vegas) finished at No. 2 while national power Farragut High (Knoxville, TN) added another top 10 finish to its records.
