Tom Succow begins his 39th year at Brophy College Preparatory having served as a teacher and College Counselor during his tenure. With the advent of the 2014 baseball season, Coach Succow begins his 37th year as Head Baseball Coach of the Broncos. During this time, Bronco teams have accumulated over 600 victories while celebrating a State Championship in 2006 and State Runners-Up in 1982, 2007 and 2012. In the last six years, 8 Brophy student athletes have signed and currently play professional baseball. There are numerous others who have gone on to play college baseball.

Mr. Succow is a 1974 graduate of Arizona State University where he earned a B.A. with emphasis in English. He also received an M.Ed in Curriculum and Instruction from Arizona State. He is married to his wife Barbara for 41 years and has 2 daughters, Kristien and Nicole, as well as a granddaughter, Kinsley.

Coach Succow has not only benefitted from working with outstanding student athletes during the past 39 years, but also tremendous assistant coaches who have impacted the lives of many young men. Since 2001, the Brophy Baseball Coaching Staff has been honored as Coaching Staff of the Year 9 times.

Mr. Succow has served on five USA Baseball National Team coaching staffs including tours as the head coach of the USA 16U team in 2004 after a year as an assistant in 2003; head coach of the 14U National team in 2006 and 2007; and most recently completed a summer long tour as an assistant of the 18U National Team in 2010. He was honored as National Coach of the Year in January of 2007 by the American Baseball Coaches Association, and is a member of two Halls of Fame being inducted into the Arizona Baseball Coaches Hall of Fame in 2003, and the Brophy Hall of Fame in 2007.
