It took a comeback victory in extra innings, but Mater Dei High (Santa Ana, CA) held onto the top spot in the Baseball America/National High School Baseball Coaches Association Top 25. The Monarchs are on a 19-game winning streak after losing their first game of the season.

Movement was minimal in the latest poll as a couple teams' losses were at the hands of ranked opponents. Tampa's Jesuit High fell three spots after losing its last two games of the regular season, but one was by one run and the second was to No. 3 Venice (FL) High. Loganville (GA) High lost two games since the last poll and dropped to No. 11. Both losses came against Gainesville (GA) High—now No. 5 in the country.

The only new team to join the Top 25 is Great Bridge High in Chesapeake, VA. The Wildcats are off to a 12-0 start.
