## **About the BCA**

**The National High School Baseball Coaches Association (BCA) was officially founded in July 1991. The purpose of this organization is to provide services and recognition for baseball coaches and to help promote and represent high school baseball across this country. The current membership has coaches representing every state that recognizes high school baseball.**

**In addition to publishing coaching instructional articles on its website ([www.baseballcoaches.org](http://www.baseballcoaches.org)), the BCA selects and honors 8 Regional and a National Player of the Year, All-Regional and All-American teams, Rookie of the Year, 8 Regional Assistant Coaches of the Year, 8 Regional Head Coaches of the Year, as well as a National Coach of the Year. The BCA also selects and honors 8 Regional and selects a National Field of the Year in collaboration with Turface Athletics.**

**The BCA partners with *Baseball America* to rank high school baseball teams during the prep season. Coaches who are members are recognized for the number of victories achieved and for years of coaching service. We also have a BCA Coaches Hall of Fame, honoring those coaches across the countries that have served their profession and our association to the highest degree.**

**A \$1,000,000.00 liability insurance coverage is included in the \$50.00 annual membership fee for USA coaches. We encourage every level of coaching (college, high school, youth, little league, club, camp instructors, private lesson) to join our association.**

**A national convention, featuring 22 outstanding clinicians, Awards/Hall of Fame dinner, trade show and a Fellowship of Christian Athletes breakfast, is conducted the weekend following Thanksgiving. The 2015 BCA Convention will be held December 3-6, 2015 in St. Louis, MO at the Hilton at the Ballpark.**
