**DURHAM, N.C.—**The Woodlands (Texas) High snapped a trend, becoming the first team this season to retain the No. 1 ranking in the Baseball America/National High School Baseball Coaches Association poll. The suburban-Houston powerhouse had won 17 in a row.

No. 2 Monsignor Pace High (Opa Locka, Fla.), No. 3 Agoura (Calif.) High and No. 4 Fallbrook (Calif.) High combined for nine losses in a two-week span, opening the top 10 for five new teams.

Nova High (Davie, Fla.) continued its climb, rising five spots to No. 2. No. 3 Jackson High (Mill Creek, Wash.) and No. 4 Cypress (Calif.) High climbed two spots each while Archbishop Rummel High (Metairie, La.) moved from No. 10 to No. 5.

The staff of Baseball America and the National High School Baseball Coaches Association compiles the Top 50 rankings. The next in-season poll will be conducted May 7, with the final poll released June 12. Records indicated as of April 17 and do not include ties.
